The Asbury Park School District will provide all students with a comprehensive and progressive education where everyone possesses the skills and character to succeed in a diverse, evolving global society.




A digital Parent School Re-Opening Survey was released to families on July 23, 2020 in English, Spanish, and Creole. The survey is still collecting data.

As of August 13th, the district has collected a total of **706 responses.**




Are you comfortable with your child returning to the building in September?






What type of school day are you comfortable with?




Overview of Re-Entry Models



- In-person instruction offered 5 days during regular school day hours
- Follows social distancing guidelines
- After-School Program available THIS OPTION WILL BE OFFERED TO PRE-K AND DESIGNATED SPECIAL EDUCATION CLASSES



- Combination of in-person and full remote instruction
- A/B Days Assigned by Grouping Group A: Last Name A-J Group B: Last Name K-Z
- Follows social distancing guidelines
- After-School program available



- Entire school day is remote/virtual
- Class work completed and submitted through a digital platform
- Scheduled virtual meetings and check-in sessions with teacher STUDENTS NEED ACCESS TO INTERNET CONNECTED DEVICE



Option 1: Traditional Model




- In-person instruction offered 5 days during regular school day hours
- Follows social distancing guidelines
- After-School Program available THIS OPTION WILL BE OFFERED TO PRE-K AND DESIGNATED SPECIAL EDUCATION CLASSES

- Modified in-person learning environment
 - Teachers responsible for implementing high-quality instruction
 - o Students responsible for completing assigned work
 - o Parents encouraged to support student learning and communicate regularly with Instructional Staff
- Applies to the following populations:
 - o All Preschool Classes
 - o Designated Special Education Classes



Option 2: Hybrid Model



- Combination of in-person and full remote instruction
- A/B Days Assigned by Grouping Group A: Last Name A-J Group B: Last Name K-Z
- Follows social distancing guidelines
- After-School program available

- Each grade grouped alphabetically to represent a reduced footprint of each building's population
- Over a 2-week period (10 days, M-F) all students will receive 5 days of In-Person Instruction and 5 days of Full Remote Instruction
 - Teachers responsible for implementing high-quality instruction
 - o Students responsible for completing assigned work
 - o Parents encouraged to support student learning and communicate regularly with Instructional Staff
- Follows scheduling specific of Phase 1, Phase 2, Phase 3 of the Re-Entry Plan



Option 2: Hybrid Model

Hybrid Model

Students grouped for reduced footprint

A/B" Day schedule for all students (Grades K-12)

Reduced population of students in Full Remote Instruction daily

Reduced population of students in In-Person Instruction daily



Option 3: Full Remote Model



- Entire school day is remote/virtual
- Class work completed and submitted through a digital platform
- Scheduled virtual meetings and check-in sessions with teacher STUDENTS NEED ACCESS TO INTERNET CONNECTED DEVICE

- Will include students of families who have selected Full Remote Instruction AND all other students (K-12) that are participating in the Hybrid Model
- Students engage in synchronous and asynchronous learning activities daily
 - o Teachers responsible for implementing high-quality instruction
 - o Students responsible for completing assigned work
 - o Parents encouraged to support student learning and communicate regularly with Instructional Staff
- Full Remote Instruction students will be able to follow the same instructional schedule as Hybrid Model through the usage of digital platforms
- During Remote Instruction students with IEP's have the option of tele-therapy as per the NJDOE Regulations
- Every Parent has a right to select full remote learning until the Phase 3 announcement is made by Governor Murphy



Scheduling: Calendar Implementation

September 8 to October 20, 2020 (Subject to Change) The district will operate in Full Remote Instruction model for 30 instructional days

 Pending additional guidance from NJDOE, child care will be provided for limited number of in-need families

October 21 to October 23, 2020 (Subject to Change)

- "Phase 1" begins
- Self-Contained Special Education programs (PK to 12) inperson everyday
- Remaining grades will remain in Full Remote

October 26 to October 30, 2020 (Subject to Change)

- Preschool, Kindergarten, Grades 4 & 5, and Grades 7,8 and 9 will be attend in-person everyday
- Remaining grades will remain in Full Remote



Scheduling: Calendar Implementation

November 2, 2020 to January 15, 2021 (Subject to Change)

• All student populations attend in-person everyday

January 19 to April 1, 2021 (Subject to Change)

- "Phase 2" begins
- Full Remote and Abbreviated Day options will be available at family request

April 12, 2021 to End of School Year (Subject to Change)

- "Phase 3" begins
- Full Remote and Abbreviated Day options will be available at family request

- Students will transition to in-person model 4 days of the week
- All students will be remote on the same day of the week (Wednesday)

Key Components:

All students/grade-levels will be in-person 5 days a week



Scheduling: Asbury Park High School

- All High School grade-levels (7 to 12) will follow each Phase of the Re-Entry Plan
 - o *Phase 1:* In-Person and Full Remote Instruction days will vary for 7/8 grade and 9-12 grade (Schedules will be sent out by building)
 - o Phase 2: 4 days in-person instruction for all grade-levels, with 1 Full Remote Instruction day
 - o Phase 3: All grade-levels in-person
- Grade-levels will have staggered start and end times for reduced footprint
- Each grade-level will follow different block schedules

Grade-Levels	Scheduled Block(s)
7 th and 8 th Grade	Blocks 1-4
9 th to 12 th Grade	Blocks 2-5



Scheduling: Exceptions

- Early Childhood
 All Preschool classrooms will be in-person 5 days a week
- Bradley Elementary School
 The following self-contained special education programs will be in-person 5 days a week:
 [2] Multiple Disabled (MD) Class Grades K to 1, Grades 2 to 4
- Thurgood Marshall Elementary School
 The following self-contained special education programs will be in-person 5 days a week:
 Language Learning Disabled (LLD) Class Grades 1 to 3
- Dr. MLK Jr. Upper Elementary School
 The following self-contained special education programs will in-person be 5 days a week:

 Cognitive Impaired (CI) Class Grades 4 to 6
 [2] Language Learning Disabled (LLD) Class Grades 4 to 6



Meals and Transportation

- Breakfast and lunch will be provided daily through a bagged "Grab and Go" model
 - O When in a Full Remote Instruction:
 - Meal pick-up sites will be designated for daily pick-up from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM
 - When using in Hybrid and/or In-Person:
 - Breakfast will be eaten in classrooms
 - Lunch for grades K to 12 will be eaten in the cafeteria and gymnasium to adhering to social distancing guidelines
 - Preschool lunch will be eaten in classrooms and adhere to social distancing guidelines
- ■Through a collaborative partnership with MOESC transportation services will continue to be provided to Preschool and Special Education students during In-Person Model
