The Class of 2020 can demonstrate graduation assessment proficiency through the same 3 pathways as those in the Classes of 2018 & 2019, provided that students in the Class of 2020 take all PARCC assessments associated with the high-school level courses for which they were eligible and receive valid scores The Class of 2021 and Beyond have 2 pathways to meet graduation assessments requirements: (1) Pass the ELA 10 and Algebra 1 assessments; or (2) The submission by the district of a student portfolio through the Department's portfolio appeals process, assuming the student has taken all PARCC assessments associated with the high-school level courses for which they were eligible and receives valid scores.
