BES TLAA students are preparing for our *Music to our Ears* production with Lakehouse. As you can see, our students made a bulletin board to show how creative they are.






Throughout January and February, our after-school students focused on Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., and Black History Month. Students listened to a diverse variety of music that was created, composed, produced or performed by African American artists throughout history. Genres included rhythm and blues, doo wop, soul, disco, reggae, funk and pop music. Diana Ross and The Supremes were a favorite among many students, as well as the musical renderings of trumpeter, composer and vocalist Louis Armstrong. In addition, we viewed a tribute to the stylings of Gregory Hines, a famous African American considered one of the most celebrated tap dancers of all time. Students compiled all they learned into a soul train - a visual representation of African American music over time.




With the help of the Second Step Program the second graders have learned how to apply positive self-talk whenever they are annoyed, angry, and frustrated with


Celebrating World Read Aloud Day After School,

On February 5, 2020, the children in our TLAA & STEAAM after school programs joined together to celebrate *World Read Aloud Day.* It was so much fun! This annual read aloud day is sponsored by *Scholastic*, and unites people around the world by highlighting the importance of reading aloud and sharing stories.

Research shows that reading aloud to children every day is proven to put them almost a year ahead of children who are not read to. In addition, the *Kids and Family Reading Report* found that 83% of kids ages 6–17 say they love or loved being read aloud to. Yet nearly one in four parents stop reading aloud to their children by the age of 9 and 40% of kids ages 6–11 wish their parents had continued reading aloud. World Read Aloud Day is designed to encourage everyone to keep reading aloud at any age.
